Recently you contacted the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (department) regarding the approval of your training program for owners and operators of regulated underground storage tanks. This letter serves to notify you that individuals completing your training program would be considered adequately trained to meet the state's requirements. A copy of completion of the training program would have to be provided to the department to document successful training.

You had previously submitted information regarding your training program as part of a submittal to the state's Petroleum Release Compensation Fund (Fund). While the Fund had solicited submittals to conduct this required training, the Ground Water Quality Program has responsibility for ensuring compliance with the regulatory requirements. The Ground Water Quality Program reviewed the technical portions of all the submittals to verify acceptability of training. Individuals completing the training as outlined in your submittal would be adequately trained for the department's purposes. If you make significant modifications to your training program, the department would need to re-evaluate it determination.
